

# AP Credit


In the table below, you can review which AP scores will be accepted as course credit toward your Lawrence degree. Generally, a 4 or 5 on an approved AP exam will be accepted for course credit, and the units awarded for AP exams can count toward the total number of units needed to graduate. In some cases, the AP score may also count as the equivalent of a Lawrence course, or the awarded AP units may make the student eligible to take higher-level classes.

Calculus AB	4-5	6 units MATH 140	Student may take placement exam for entry into MATH 155. If student elects to take MATH 140, no credit will be awarded. Credit fulfills quantitative competency GER.
Calculus BC	4-5	6 units MATH 140	Student may take placement exam for entry into MATH 155. If student elects to take MATH 140, no credit will be awarded. Credit fulfills quantitative competency GER.
Chemistry	4	6 units CHEM elective	Student may take placement exam for entry into CHEM 116.
Chemistry	5	6 units CHEM 115	Student may take placement exam for entry into CHEM 116.
Chinese Language & Culture	4-5	6 units CHJA	Student should consult CHJA for appropriate course placement in department. Credit fulfills language competency GER.
Computer Science A	4-5	6 units CMSC	Student may take CMSC 250. Credit fulfills quantitative competency GER.
Computer Science Principles	4-5	6 units CMSC	No advanced placement awarded in CMSC. Credit fulfills quantitative competency GER.

English Language & Composition	4-5	6 units ENG	No advanced placement awarded in ENG.
English Literature & Composition	4-5	6 units ENG	Student has completed the equivalent of a 100level English course.
Environmental Science	4-5	6 units ENST 150	Student has completed the equivalent of ENST 150.
European History	4-5	6 units HIST	Student has completed the equivalent of a 100level History course and should consult History department for appropriate course placement.
French Language & Culture	4-5	6 units FREN	Student may take placement exam for entry into 200-level FREN course. Credit fulfills language competency GER.
German Language & Culture	4-5	6 units GER	Student may take placement exam for entry into 200-level GER course. Does not fulfill language competency GER.
Government and Politics: Comparative	4-5	6 units GOVT	No advanced placement, but can be counted as an elective in the GOVT major.
Government and Politics: US	4-5	6 units GOVT	No advanced placement, but can be counted as an elective in the GOVT major.
Human Geography	4-5	6 units ANTH	No advanced placement in ANTH.
Italian Language & Culture	4-5	6 units UNIC	Student may take placement exam for entry into UNIC 201 (Intermediate Transitional Italian). Credit fulfills language competency GER.
Japanese Language & Culture	4-5	6 units CHJA	Student should consult CHJA for appropriate course placement in department. Credit fulfills language competency GER.
Latin	3	0 units	Student may enroll in CLAS 220.
Latin	4	6 units CLAS	Student may enroll in 300-level courses in Latin literature. Credit fulfills language competency GER.

Latin	5	6 units CLAS	Student may enroll in 400-level courses in Latin literature. Credit fulfills language competency GER.
Macroeconomics	4-5	6 units ECON	No advanced placement awarded in ECON. Credit fulfills quantitative competency GER.

Microeconomics	4-5	100	Econ faculty member for appropriate course placement. Credit fulfills quantitative competency GER.
Music Theory	4-5	6 units MUTH	Student may take Lawrence's Advanced Placement Exam in Music Theory for advanced placement in the music theory core curriculum.
Physics 1	4-5	6 units PHYS	Student may receive no more than 12 units of credit for multiple AP PHYSICS exams. Student should consult physics department chair for appropriate course placement. Credit fulfills quantitative competency GER.
Physics 2	4-5	6 units PHYS	Student may receive no more than 12 units of credit for multiple AP PHYSICS exams. Student should consult physics department chair for appropriate course placement. Credit fulfills quantitative competency GER.
Physics C Electricity & Magnetism	4-5	6 units PHYS	Student may receive no more than 12 units of credit for multiple AP PHYSICS exams. Student should consult physics department chair for appropriate course placement. Credit fulfills quantitative competency GER.
Physics C - Mechanics	4-5	6 units PHYS	Student may receive no more than 12 units of credit for multiple AP PHYSICS exams. Student should consult physics department chair for appropriate course placement.

Precalculus	4-5	6 units MATH 103	Student may take placement exam for entry into MATH 140. If student elects to take MATH 103, no credit will be awarded. Credit fulfills quantitative competency GER.
Psychology	4-5	6 units PSYC 100	Student has completed the equivalent of PSYC 100.
Spanish Language & Culture	4-5	6 units SPAN 202	Student has completed the equivalent of SPAN 202, which will also fulfill Lawrence's language competency GER. Student may register for Spanish courses numbered 300 and above.
Spanish Literature & Culture	4-5	6 units SPAN 320	Student has completed the equivalent of SPAN 320 which will also fulfill Lawrence's language competency GER. Student may register for Spanish courses numbered 400 and above.
Statistics	4-5	6 units of STAT 107	Credit fulfills quantitative competency GER.
Studio Art - 2D Design	4-5	6 units ART	Student may take any 200-level course in studio art.
Studio Art - 3D Design	4-5	6 units ART	Student may take any 200-level course in studio art.
Studio Art - Drawing	4-5	6 units ART	Student may take any 200-level course in studio art.
US History	4-5	6 units HIST	Student has completed the equivalent of a 100level History course and should consult History department for appropriate course placement.
World History	4-5	6 units HIST	Student has completed the equivalent of a 100level History course and should consult History department for appropriate course placement.
